# Effective January 10, 2022:

In our efforts to keep our congregation safe during cold, flu, and virus season, the leadership of Mariners Bethel UMC is recommending the following:

- 1. **Mask guidelines at the church remain the same.** Masks are strongly suggested, but not required. Social distancing, frequent hand washing, and use of hand sanitizers are recommended. A supply of masks and hand sanitizer are available for use at the church.
- 2. **In-house worship will resume on Sunday, January 16, 2022.** Services will also be offered online. We will offer overflow seating in the Social Hall if the Sanctuary is too crowded. The Red Vests will be available to help.

- 3. Church offices will reopen Monday, January 10, 2022, from 10 AM 2 PM. Emails and phones will be monitored all day during business hours.
- 4. Small groups, adult studies, classes, and ministries are encouraged to be in contact with their group members to determine if in-person meetings will take place. **This decision to meet is left up to the individual groups.** Leaders of these groups are asked to contact the office if their plans to meet are altered or changed so we can help inform those who ask.
- 5. **Foodservice restrictions remain in place**. All meals should be prepared safely with necessary precautions in the kitchen. Seating in the Social Hall or Hope Center Gym is limited to 50-75 percent occupancy to allow for safe spacing between tables. Food must be plated by those in the kitchen, and the plate handed to the person who will take it to the table to eat. No buffet-style meals are permitted at this time. Attendees may bring their own picnic/brown bag meal.
- 6. As always, anyone not feeling comfortable or feeling ill, or who has been in contact recently with someone diagnosed with COVID, is encouraged to stay home.

Please feel free to share this information with others who may be affected.

This group meets every Tuesday via Zoom from 9-10:30 AM.


