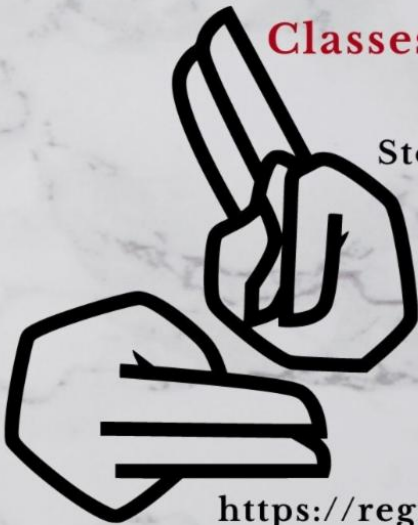

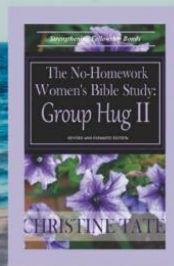

Altar Flower Sign Up Sheets are posted on the bulletin board in the mail room.

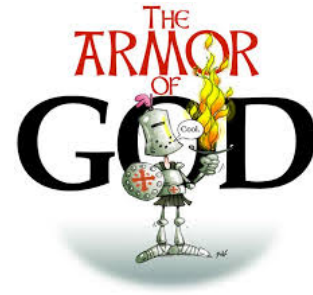

You will receive a secure, self-guided setup process to tie your phone to your Church Center donor account and a payment source. After that, giving is as easy as sending a text.
