"Charting Our Course"

When sailors didn't have charts or maps, they used a **SEXTANT** as a navigational tool to find their way. Three key elements are needed to use the sextant:

- Light in order to see clearly
- The sun as a source of determining the direction from the heavens
- The horizon as a source of the earth below

The path forward was then established by determining the distance between the heavens and earth, illuminated by light. At Mariners, we are taking a similar approach to "Charting our Course."

We are in unpredictable seas within this unique season. For that reason, we will be providing opportunities in the months of September, October, and November to discern our direction and path to get to where God is calling us to be.

For light, **FAITH FORMATION** is essential to clearly see God in the midst of all our questions. All Mariners members are encouraged to be actively involved in small groups and studies having a spiritual and scriptural basis. Sign-ups are currently underway for Alpha, re-starts of small accountability groups, and Women's Central as well as current Sunday School and group studies. Faith is strengthened when Christ is the daily Light of our Life and is regularly rekindled by the Spirit in the community.

For the heavenly focus, **PRAYER AND DISCERNMENT** is key. Morning and evening prayer opportunities are being offered to create space for "two or more to gather together" in focused prayer as our

next steps are discerned.

For the earthly focus, **LISTENING POST SESSIONS** are necessary to gather accurate information. Each session will begin with a presentation. People may submit written questions in advance and on the night of the meeting. Those questions will then be presented to the speaker through the moderator. This is not a debate.

Four listening post sessions are scheduled from 6:30 – 8:00 p.m. on the following dates to allow different voices in the conversation space to share experiences and information from their own perspective.

- **Tuesday, Oct. 25** – Wesleyan Covenant Association/Global Methodist Church: Rev. David Bennett, Pen Del WCA
- **Tuesday, Nov. 1** – Next Generation of the UMC: Rev. Tom Pasmore, Asbury UMC, Salisbury, MD
- **Monday, Nov. 28** – Disaffiliation and the Independent Church: Rev. Bruce Rogers, Long Neck Church

In January, Mariners leadership will determine if disaffiliation is our direction or if we are going to wait and see what happens at the 2024 General Conference of the United Methodist Church. More information will be shared at that time.

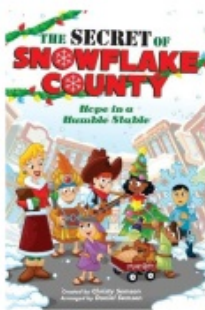

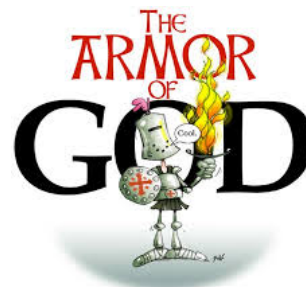

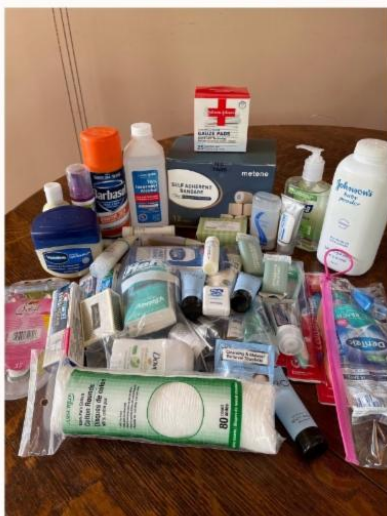
