

Mariners Disaffiliation Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

How did the Shepherding Council arrive at this position?

Since Mariners Shepherding Council originally submitted our June 2022 letter to the District Superintendent to explore disaffiliation, the congregation has spent months in investigation, prayer, and discernment to arrive at our recommendation to disaffiliate from the UMC. This discernment process (<u>Charting Our Course</u>) included all the <u>Listening Post</u> sessions, small group meetings, and classes to study the conference-mandated book, *Living Faithfully*, and twice weekly corporate prayer gatherings to seek God's guidance for the future of Mariners.

We are grateful that the leaders within our church have encouraged a thorough

exploration and prayerful discernment to generate an informed and Spirit-led decision about our future.

What if I don't agree with our stance on human sexuality? Is there still a place for me in this church or the GMC?

ABSOLUTELY! Mariners Bethel affirms the sacred worth of all persons, created in the image of God and that God's grace is available to all. With regard to human sexuality, the congregation will seek to live together in Christian community, welcoming, forgiving and loving one another, as Christ has loved and accepted us.

We believe that all persons need the ministry of the Church in their struggles for human fulfillment and the spiritual and emotional care of a fellowship that enables reconciling relationships with God, with others, and with self. We will continue to affirm that love for our neighbor - as an expression of God's infinite love for humankind - is a compelling command for us to work toward for the well-being of every single member of our communities.

Here is another opportunity to become more informed about the vote. We hope that you will make every effort to attend the forum this Saturday morning at 10 AM.

Path to the Vote Ongoing - Discernment, Faith Formation & Prayer

Saturday, February 25, 2023 - Forum on Human Sexuality and the Church at 10 AM. This is a conference requirement in order for a conference representative to unpack and debrief the 4-week study for participants.

This event will not be live-streamed or recorded. In-person only.

Saturday, March 11, 2023 - Special Charge Conference at 10 AM to vote on whether or not to disaffiliate from the UMC; members must be present to vote. Following the vote, if the disaffiliation motion is passed, the DS will conclude and a separate vote will be held among the members present to determine if Mariners will be going with the Global Methodist Church upon completion of all requirements.

This event will not be live-streamed or recorded. In-person only.

June 8-10, 2023 - Peninsula Delaware Annual Conference at location TBD/online viewing of proceeding will be offered. At the Conference, delegates will vote on the disaffiliation resolutions from churches in the conference. If passed by a simple majority vote, then churches will be considered no longer part of the UMC once all paperwork and payments have been made (by December 31, 2023 deadline).




