




1. Lunch servers on Tuesdays from 11:00 - 1 PM. Set up and clean up helpers also needed.






Pantry Partners helps fill the shelves of needier churches in our area.

The Feed My Sheep pantry helps needy families with boxes of food, produce, and bakery items.

- We fill 35-40 boxes per week.
- We give out 28 boxes every week in Frankford.




We could use a few more team members for evening lock-up...

By Text - Send a text to 84321. Placing a dollar amount in the text area with no words will apply the donation to the current expenses of the Church, the dollar amount followed by the word "gap" will go to the Stand in the Gap – Hope Center Fund to pay down the debt of the building.

Cash or Check - Checks made out to Mariners Bethel United Methodist Church can be mailed directly to 81 Central Ave., Ocean View, DE 19970. Cash or checks may be dropped off at the church and placed into the locked collection box located outside of the front office or placed into the church collections during services.
