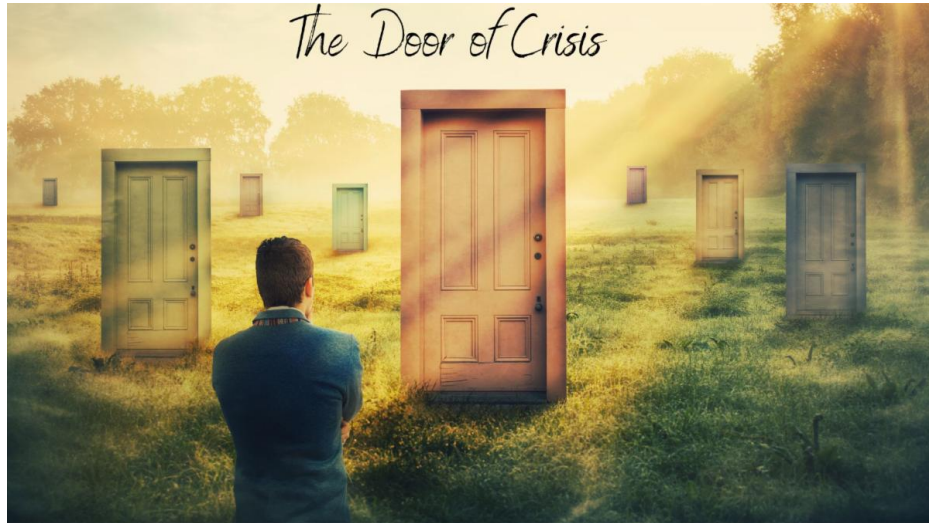

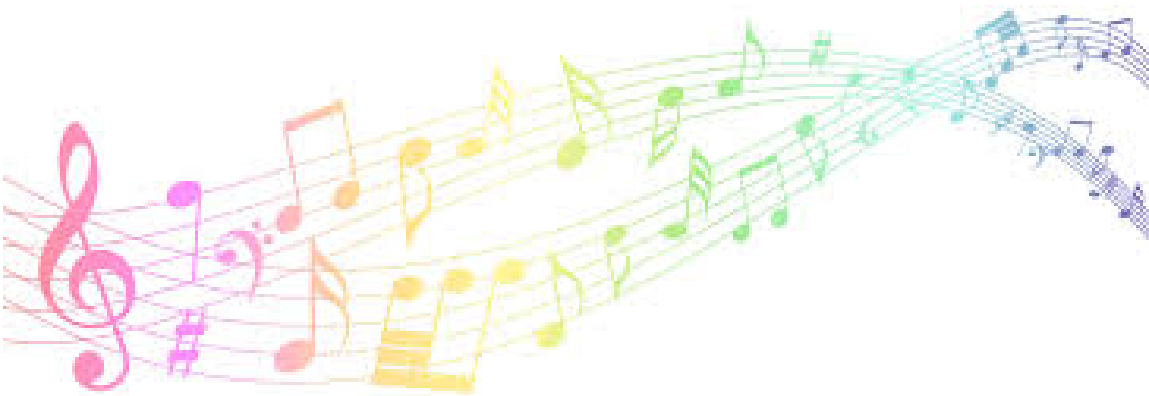



Altar Guild

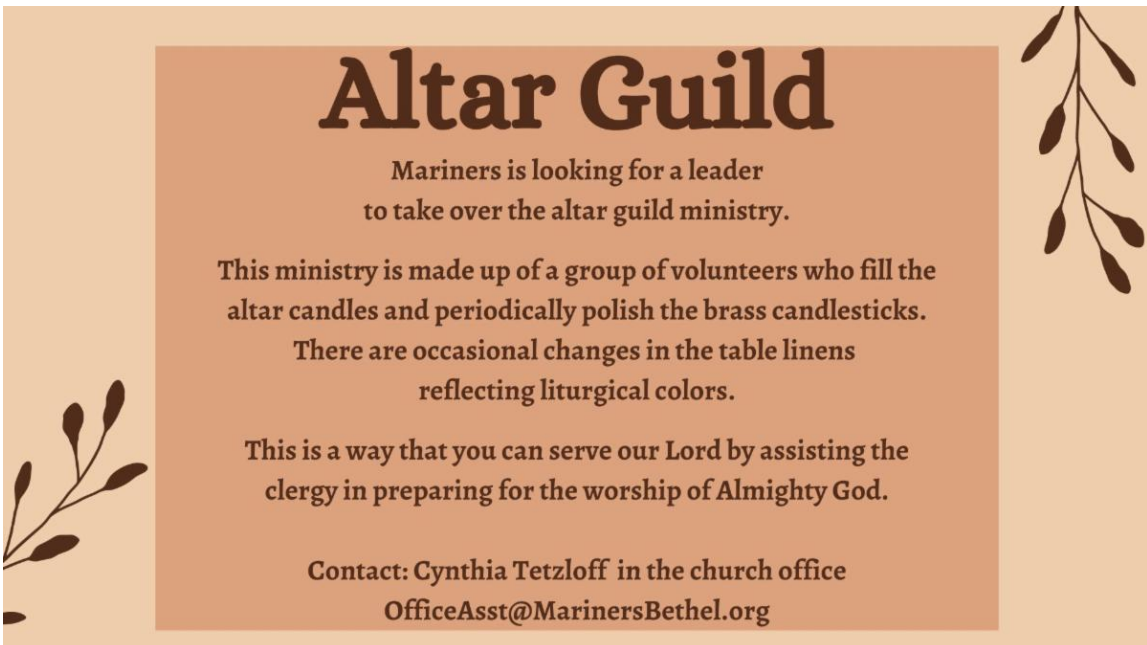
Mariners is looking for a leader to take over the altar guild ministry.

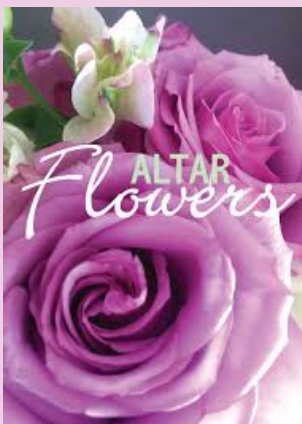
