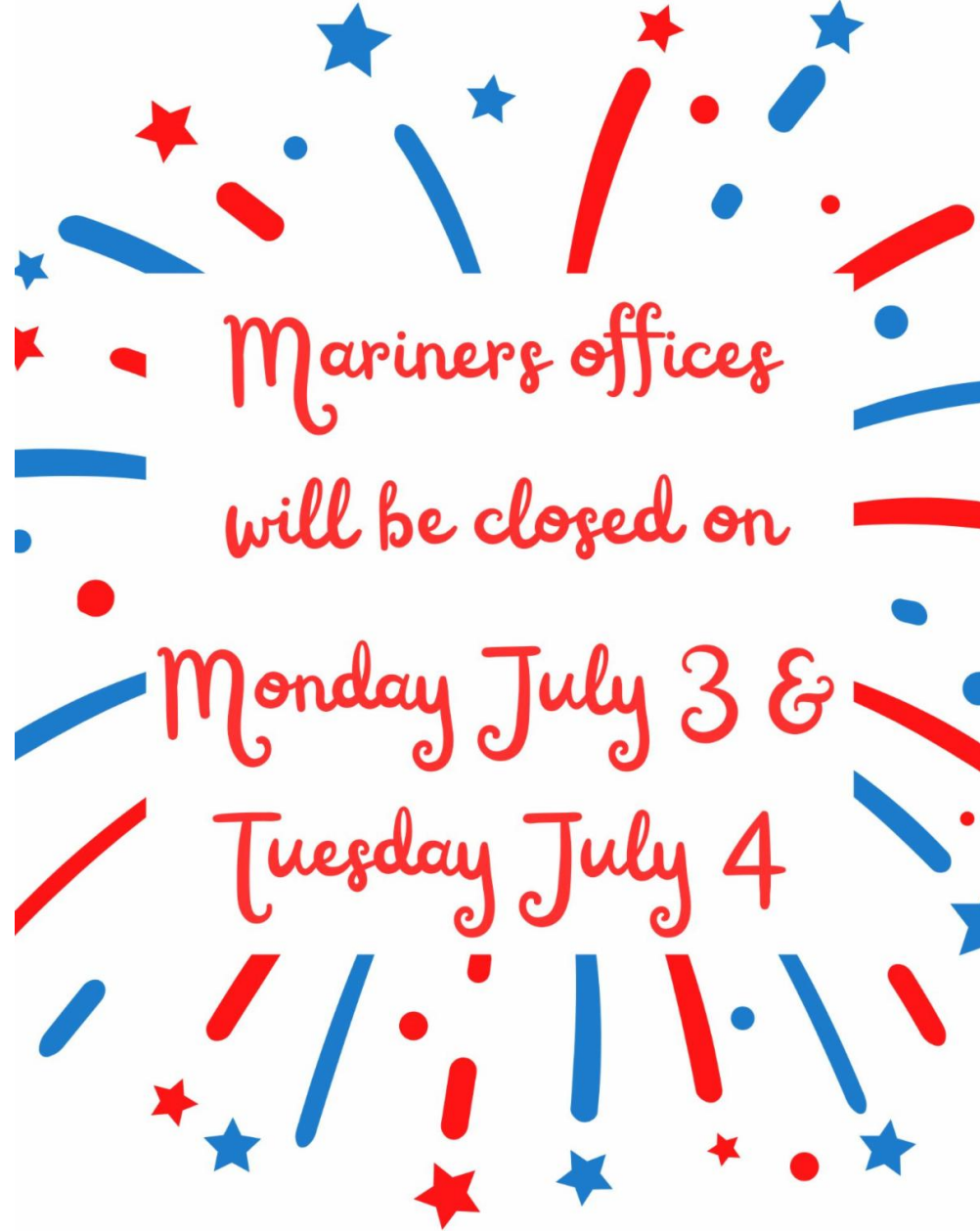

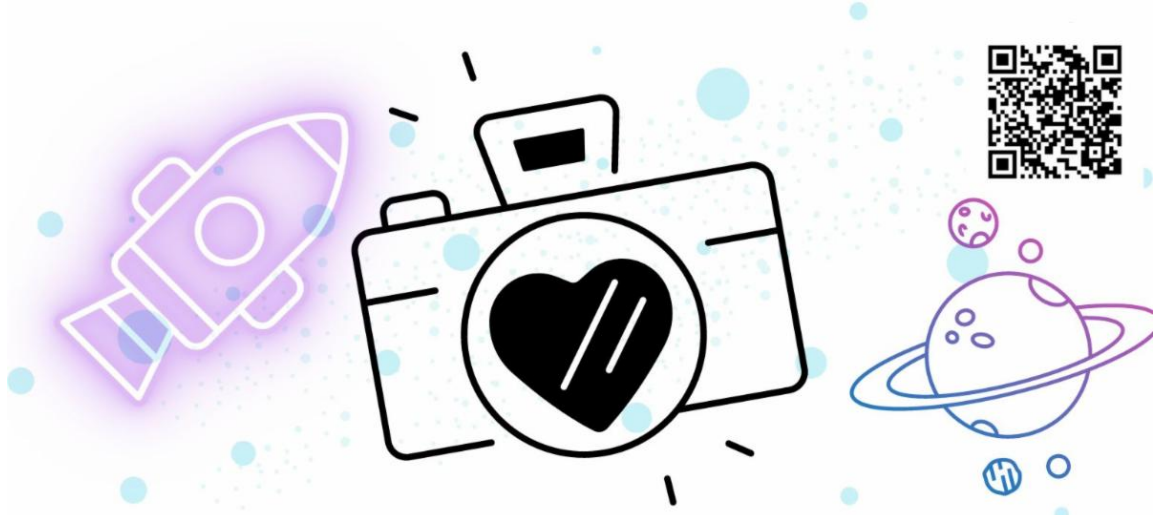

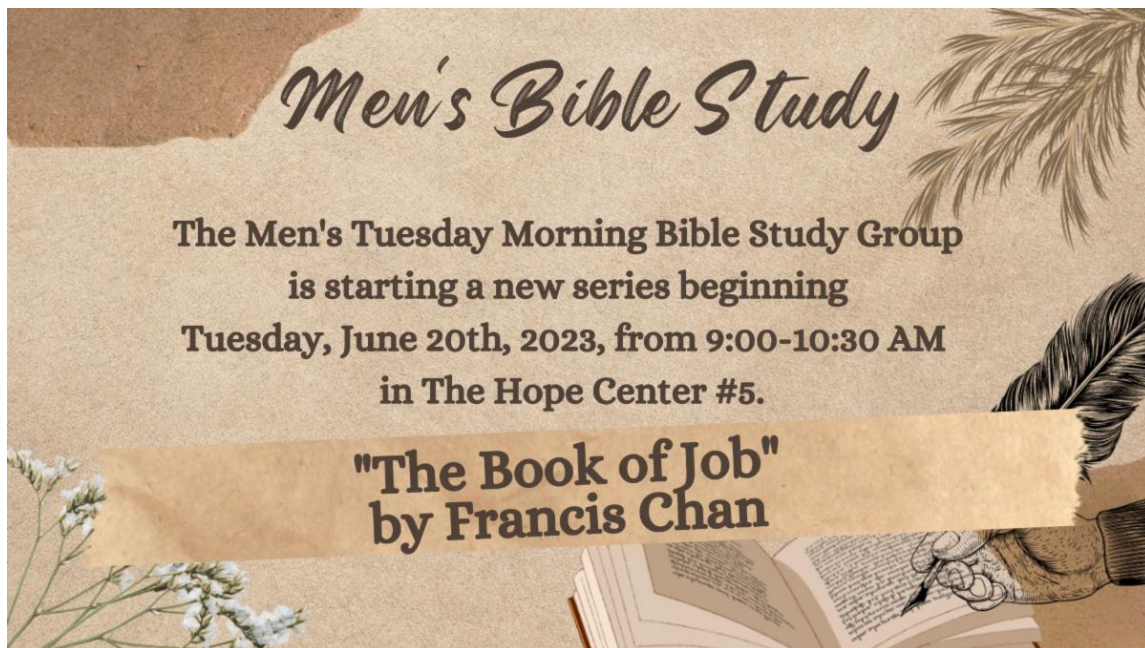

Altar Guild

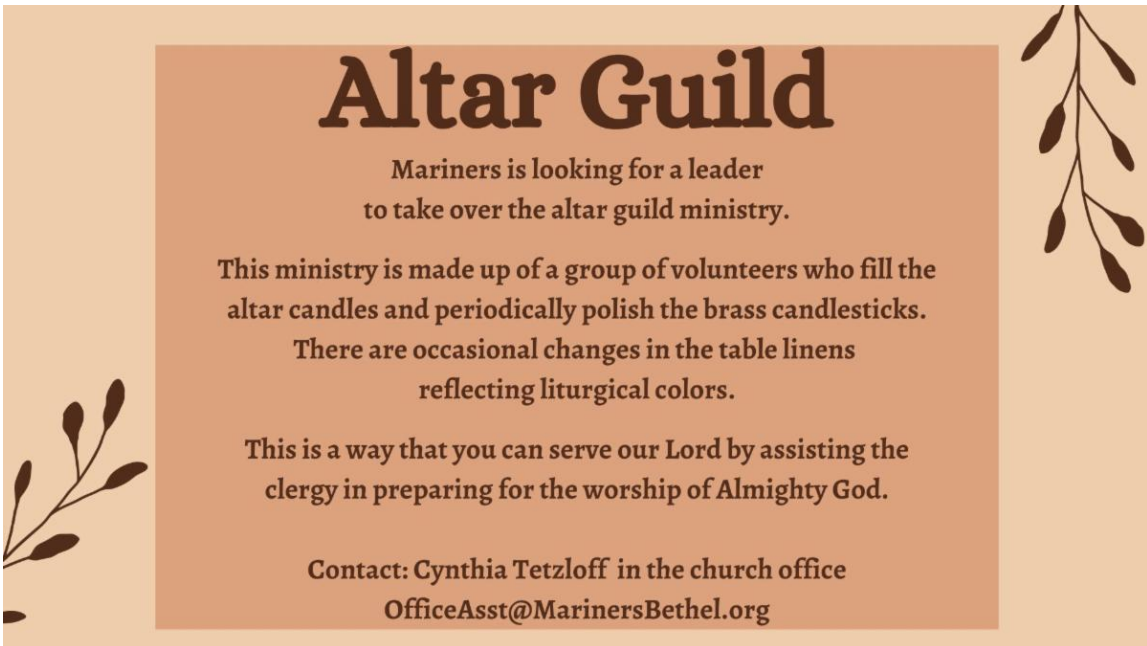
Mariners is looking for a leader
